

Flag Judging and Score Card turn in

When each Unit's Patrols have finished the William D. Boyce Challenge, Score Cards and Patrol Flags are to be turned in at the Judging Station at Administration.

Judging criteria and points will be award as follows:

Originality: The Patrol Flag may be of any shape and design and must display the Troop number & patrol names in an original manor. It should also show something about the Scouts in the patrol.

Suitability: A patrol flag is meant to be carried on a stave of 1 1/8 X 60 inches. Please keep in mind that the flag should not be so heavy that a younger Scout could not carry it.

Workmanship: The patrol flag must be homemade by the patrol members and not commercially manufactured.

The top Patrol flags will receive awards Sunday at the Closing Ceremony. Patrols can collect their Patrol Flag at the Campfire Assembly Saturday night.
